  - ✓ File format: Microsoft PowerPoint or PDF.
  - ✓ File name: <abstract ID>\_<last name>.pptx
    - Examples: "S7.3\_Yabuki.pptx": abstract ID is "S7.3", and last name is "Yabuki", "Keynote.4\_Kool.pptx": abstract ID is "Keynote.4", and last name is "Kool".
- Preparation procedure
  - ✓ Recommendation
    - When producing PowerPoint/PDF files, we recommend embedding all used fonts in order to guarantee a smooth presentation.

- Please use the laptop PC prepared in the session room, on which each presenter's presentation materials are uploaded by the secretariat in advance.
- The PC will run on Windows 11 with Microsoft Office PowerPoint 2021 and Adobe Acrobat Reader.
