












Location of the Science Council of Japan, Roppongi, Tokyo

Oral Presentations:

- All oral presentations will be made/served via the online Meeting Application (Zoom).
- Presenters can attend the "Zoom" by either "in person at the Science Council of Japan" or by "online"
- Presenters are allocated for 10-30 min. of talks depending on the programme of each session.


